Footnotes

GOLD'N HOLIDAY tracked the pace three wide, forged command with a quarter to run, opened clear and widened. MADILLAC D'VILLE disputed the pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but had enough left to hold the place. MOUNT DOLLBERG settled between horses, launched his bid four wide, lacked the needed late response and settled for the show. DELVIN'S A HATER contended along the inside but lacked a response when called upon. BIG STAGE was unhurried into stride, angled out and finished with a belated gain. PLEASANT MAN set the pressured pace three wide, came up empty between horses on the second turn and dropped out. ROLL ON ROUGE showed little.
