EYE FOR AN EYE vied for the lead along the inside, kept on gamely through a prolonged drive, drifted out and bumped MAXIMOSO near the sixteenth pole, was straightened away and proved unyielding. FREDRIK THE GREAT attended the pace off of the inside, angled out entering the stretch, kept on well and was gaining. MAXIMOSO settled in hand, moved up five wide to make his bid, poked his head in front a furlong out, was bumped when the winner came out near the sixteenth pole and weakened. A MANS MAN was bumped at the start, closed the gap along the inside, angled out entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. STREET SHOES LARRY was allowed to settle, came three wide and improved position between horses. SILVERDADDYOFMINE was forwardly placed between horses to the stretch and faded. TIGER STRIKE broke awkwardly, was unhurried into stride, circled the field and finished with a belated gain. HE CAN HE WILL passed the tiring ones. DUTCH REWARD contested the pace three wide to the stretch and

retreated. AMERICAN AT WAR showed little. MAD AFTERSHOCK made a middle move five wide, but was through after a half. ZIMMARON KID broke inwardly bumping A MANS MAN and came up empty thereafter.
