**Footnotes**

HANUMAN outsprinted early, advanced three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed fast to win going away. CRIMSON'S ROAR vied for the lead three wide, was no match for the winner late but was clearly second best. USKA'S WALL CAT within striking distance in the four path, tired in the drive. WINE TIME stumbled after the start, was outrun for a half, angled out for the drive and showed late interest. MATT'S CONCORD within reach from the start, saved ground on the turn and could not threaten. DISTINCT ADVANTAGE forced the pace off the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. DR LOCO LOCOCO reserved early, raced along the inside on the turn and could not menace. BANDICEK four wide on the turn, was no threat. HOMECOURTADVANTAGE four wide late on the turn, had no response in the stretch. ZAPATON was outrun. MR JESS E with the early pace inside rivals, stopped.
