Footnotes

SPARKLING HUMOR gained the lead early, went along under careful handling, turned back a bid from POPOZINHA approaching the stretch, then drove clear under pressure. POPOZINHA chased the winner from early on while four wide, challenged him briefly approaching the stretch and wasn't good enough. SECRET CONQUEST, carried out early, settled in behind horses, split foes entering the final furlong four wide and was going well at the end. MAYBE CORA, checked between horses early, moved four or five wide, reached contention entering the upper stretch and failed to continue. HALODRAMATIC, checked on the first turn, raced six wide in a striking position but failed to rally. TOLU tracked the leaders four or five wide into the stretch and flattened out. CONFIRMED TEMPER, well placed inside, weakened leaving the second turn. NATIVE FEVER, checked early, failed to rally. R LADY DEPUTY tired after five furlongs. SWISS VALLEY tired after a half. UNBRIDLED LIL STAR was outrun. RED BAND RUN, checked in tight after the start, bore out nearing the first turn bothering HALODRAMATIC, then was done early.
