**Footnotes**

JAZZAMATASSLE settled inside, split foes while rallying into the lane three wide, took over inside front-running CHARLIE PAPA in the final furlong and drove clear under hand urging. CHARLIE PAPA tracked the pace early while five wide, took over before going a half, drew clear, then wasn't a match for the winner late. CITY DIAMOND, outrun for a half, rallied eight wide into the lane and bested the others. SUMMER SAVOYA, never far back, moved up between horses four wide for the drive but was empty late. MARK OF TEXAS, outrun to the stretch, improved position with a minor gain but wasn't a threat. BEAUTY TO BOOT contested the pace along the inside for a half and dropped back. PRISON OF LOVE failed to rally. PANA GIRL raced forwardly for a half while four wide and weakened thereafter. SARA'S SARA LEE tired early on the turn. LADY MATTY raced off the inside and faded upon going a half. LADY DUMAANI battled for the lead from between foes for a half and tired.
