**Footnotes**

LORAMATEAL, a bit sluggish to begin and bumped soon after the break by HARMONIC MISS, was unhurried, commenced her rally three furlongs out, moved six or seven wide into the lane and closed determinedly to be along in time. ANGEL TRUMPET pressed front-running G G'S DOLLY from early on while four wide, took over in the upper stretch, drew clear, then failed to last. JULES BEST, within striking distance and five or six wide, loomed a solid threat in the final furlong but couldn't offer the needed response. HARMONIC MISS leaned in after the start and bumped the winner, tracked the pace five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. FREE BONUS, well placed in behind foes early, lost position on the turn, came out five or six wide for the drive and offer a mild gain. SEEINSBELIEVEN, near the inside, failed to rally in an even effort. SEA SIREN wasn't a factor. ASHLEY AND I bobbed at the start, gained a forward position near the inside, raced in contention to the stretch and weakened. SACRED FEATHER, six wide most of the way, was outrun. G G'S DOLLY gained the lead early three wide, made the pace for three furlongs and gave way readily in the drive.
