FAMOUS FROLIC reserved along the inside, responded in the stretch and finished willingly to be up late along the inside. BUCK WARRIOR close up along the inside, challenged inside the leaders once in the stretch and held on gamely only to be outfinished. COPY RUNNER stumbled at the start, was outrun along the inside, angled out five wide approaching the stretch when rallying and closed well on the outside. KENONSON'S COUNT stumbled at the start, recovered quickly to be prominent four wide, challenged on the turn, took over with a furlong to go but faltered late. ONE EYED GAMBLER within striking distance, moved out four wide midway through the turn, maintained good position into the final furlong but lacked a late bid. GRAVEN vied for the lead off the inside and weakened. CONTROVERSY forced the pace off the inside and tired. BATES CITY prompted the pace three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired.
