ZAMBEZI WARRIOR was forwardly placed along the inside, dropped back through the turn, shifted out and came again from between horses, struck the front with a furlong to run and gamely kicked clear. GOLD FOR GLORY pressed the pace along the inside, dropped back through the turn, got through and came again in the drive and was up in time to earn the place. DOWN THE TRACK settled saving ground, swung five wide leaving the turn to make a late rally and was just along to gain a minor award. SECRET COMMANDER stalked the pace four wide, bid between horses entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. COMEBACK was allowed to settle, came three wide to make a late rally, was blocked and steadied in the drive, altered course to the outside late but was left with too much to do. SUDDENLY PERFECT saved ground to little avail. YES MONEY set the pressured pace between horses, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. MAGIC DE NASKRA broke slowly, rushed to contention five wide but failed to sustain the drive. MCGAULEY advanced from between horses for a striking position, loomed large leaving the turn but stopped. DR. ALBERT O broke slowly and trailed throughout.
