Footnotes

TOUCH ME QUICK veered out bumping SEINNE SHIP at the start, rushed up four wide, wore down MAC DOOGLE and edged clear late. MAC DOOGLE set the pressured pace along the inside, was unable to resist the winner but stayed on willingly to hold the place. SEINNE SHIP was bumped at the start, made a middle move four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. SLIPPIN AWAY was allowed to settle, angled out leaving the turn and finished with a belated gain. CRYPTO PETE was unhurried into stride, made a mild rally circling five wide but failed to threaten. GOLDEN LAUCHER contended between horses, checked hard near the seven-sixteenths pole and showed little thereafter. HONOUR TO WIN was hustled along off of the inside, came four wide to make a mild bid but came up empty after a half and retreated. WAYLON'S GHOST was close up off of the inside, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole and dropped out readily.
