Footnotes

NATIVE RULER settled in hand, advanced between horses through the turn, came three wide, took over and quickly drew clear. A DIEHL was allowed to settle, angled out leaving the turn and finished willingly to earn the place. SNAPSHOT rushed to the lead five wide, angled in to set the pace, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. PHAT DAY attend the pace along the inside, but flattened in the final furlong and faded. HARLAN STREET was unhurried into stride, angled out and finished with a belated gain. GOOD LORD broke a step slow, closed the gap along the inside, steadied from a tight spot near the quarter pole, got through and came again with a mild rally. AUSPICIOUS RISK was allowed to settle, angled out but found his best stride too late. RONIN DAX was fractious in post parade and unseated his jockey, raced wide throughout and failed to threaten. AGASTACHE was forwardly placed between horses through the turn and retreated. GRAND TRAVERSE broke sharply, was reserved off of the pace, made an early move six wide, but came up empty entering the stretch an dropped out. MATTY'S TRAIL showed little.
