Footnotes

CAT'S GLOW gained a narrow lead inside early, eased out to show the way four or five wide under careful handling, shook off VIVA LA FRANCE entering the stretch, kicked clear, then prevailed under solid hand urging. LADY FROM SHANGHAI, well placed from early on while in behind horses, raced between rivals into the lane, angled out five wide at the eighth pole, loomed a solid threat but wasn't good enough. SYNERGISTIC, unhurried early, made a solid run five wide on the far turn to reach contention, came out farther on the course for the drive and was slowly gaining at the end. DREW AWAY went up early to gain a position four or five wide, tracked the leaders into the final furlong and came up empty. VIVA LA FRANCE, bumped at the start, went up soon after to press the winner from the outside, raced close up into the stretch and faltered. VAL U ME came out at the break bumping VIVA LA FRANCE, moved inside but was empty in the drive. SEEWWHATIMSAYING failed to rally. BRUSH ARBOR never was prominent. MUSIC MUSE was outrun. CONVERSION was done early.
