PLATINEE tracked the pace five wide, went after front-running MISS HELEN WHEELS nearing the stretch, wrested command, then drew off under mild hand urging as much the best. MARGE S, within striking distance four or five wide to the lane, couldn't menace the winner in the drive while all out to earn the place. MISS HELEN WHEELS gained the advantage early, raced four wide, held on well for six furlongs and weakened. BRUSSELS LACE never threatened. PRINCESS LOLA failed to reach contention. UP THE ACCOUNT wasn't a factor. FAXY DECOR followed the pace in a striking position five or six wide to the far turn and tired. SUPERFECTA WAGERING ON THIS RACE WAS CANCELED.
