Footnotes

MOHIGAN HILL, reserved early and five wide, commenced a sweeping rally three furlongs out, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove clear under strong handling. HEZA WILD GUY gained a slim lead early while three wide, dueled first with G ALL DAY, put him away, was engaged nearing the stretch by SIR TRAVER, shook him off, but wasn't a match for the winner late. SIR TRAVER stalked the pace five wide, moved to challenge nearing the lane but flattened out in the drive. SERIOUS ALERT tracked the pace in hand four wide for five furlongs and gradually weakened. G ALL DAY contested the pace to the end of the backstretch and weakened. TRIFECTA AND SUPERFECTA WAGERING ON THIS RACE WERE CANCELED.
