BOLD PEAKS behind the pace four wide, challenged on the turn, drew clear into the stretch and maintained a comfortable lead while kept to the task. SENORITA'S SECRETS within striking distance, raced three wide while between rivals on the turn, angled out for the drive and finished willingly for the place. O MOON outsprinted early, raced in the three path and lacked a late bid. NEVAEH'S SONG squeezed at the start, quickly gained good position, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late bid. ALL A GLITTER in tight at the start, angled out soon after, raced five wide midway through the turn and could not menace. KAR KAY GIRL alternated for the lead three wide and tired. BY THE OUNCE drifted out at the start, vied for the lead inside and stopped.
