SISTER RESISTOR wide early when outsprinted, moved up five wide into the second turn, challenged approaching the stretch, took over in midstretch and drew clear under steady handling. KEITH'S KITTEN pressed the pace three wide, challenged between rivals approaching the stretch, was no match for the winner 9in the drive but stayed on for the place. MS. THANKSGIVING set the pace off the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. AUTUMN BELLS made an early move to a forward position five wide, challenged four wide on the second turn but tired in the drive. CACTUS CADILLAC close up three wide, held on well to the three furlong marker and tired. EXQUISITE MISS never far back, saved ground on the second turn and gave way. BLAZING SASHA outrun early, raced four wide out of the second turn and was no factor. STRONG EVIDENCE was through early. LADY O'DWYER was no threat.
