FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start.

Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry by payment of \$2,500 (includes entry and starting fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. The Association's money to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth.

Weight: Three-Year-Olds, 120 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice in 2010 allowed 2 lbs., A sweepstakes in 2010, allowed 4 lbs., \$30,000 twice since September 1, 2009, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The race will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights preferred. In the case of ties, second preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest earnings in 2010. However, two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and the supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

NATIVE RULER close up while off the inside, angled out for the drive, wore down the leader and drew clear. AGASTACHE set the pace along the inside, responded in the stretch and held on gamely while not quite good enough. CAIXA ELETRONICA within striking distance along the inside, angled out with a sixteenth to go but lodged only a mild bid. CASSOULET pressed the pace off the inside, stayed on well to inside the final furlong and tired. SILVER CRAFT forwardly placed three wide, tired. MATTY'S TRAIL was no threat. POSSE CAT within striking distance, raced four wide midway through the turn and faded.
