PART'N PARCEL pulled to contention four wide, tracked the pace in hand, took over nearing the quarter pole, opened clear and widened through the drive. MIAMI ICE was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, angled out five wide entering the stretch and finished willingly to earn the place. MY BUDDY BUBBA disputed the pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner, weakened further in the drive and settled for the minor award. MERCEDES CLASS was unhurried into stride, angled out five wide and improved position through the lane. MAJOR KEENE contended off of the inside to the stretch and faded. YES IT'S HOT failed to respond. SONNY JOY moved up four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. MYBROTHERRON showed little. RAJON was outrun. NATIVEMAN vied for the lead two wide, was collared between horses on the second turn and stopped.
