Footnotes

TIGRESS WOODS, never far back while racing in hand between foes early, moved five wide on the far turn, continued five abreast into the lane and wore down MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE in the last lunge. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE, well placed from early on, was also between horses, edged up four wide on the far turn, took over, then was outfinished. CAPTAIN'S DAUGHTER, within striking distance throughout and five wide, lacked a final response. SUGAR CANDY stalked front-running KAY'S DAUGHTER from early on, raced five or six wide most of the way and was empty the last eighth. DANGEROUS GIRL, outrun to the stretch while in behind horses, came out six wide for the drive and offered a minor gain. MACY B. improved position but wasn't a threat. DANCE TO DAWN failed to menace. KAY'S DAUGHTER gained the lead early, drew well clear, raced four or five wide and tired upon going six furlongs. RE LYD weakened entering the far turn. TWOINDYTOO was finished after a half.
