Footnotes

SILVER WAND settled near the inside early, moved between foes nearing the final quarter, angled seven wide for the drive and was along in time. SOUNDLESS leaned in at the start exchanging bumps with MARCHELLA, was never far back, advanced four or five wide into the lane, drifted out a bit at the sixteenth pole and couldn't last. BEAUGESTE went up early to force the pace from between foes, raced forwardly into the lane and was empty late. DOMESTIC ARTS, outsprinted early and six or seven wide most of the way, offered a mild gain. MARCHELLA came out at the start bumping with SOUNDLESS, raced in contention throughout and failed to offer a late account. CONDUCT, well placed five wide, loomed a strong threat for the final furlong and flattened out. CARSON'S STAR moved near the inside early and failed to rally. CALL ME CHIEF gained the lead early, made the pace to the lane and faltered. JENNY TUDOR (GB) was outrun. SILVER KITTY tired approaching the stretch. DASHA attended the pace from between horses early, raced forwardly for nearly three eighths and faded.
