Footnotes

DOTTIE POO settled in behind horses early, raced three wide, angled to the rail leaving the turn, gained command when roused, then was gathered up late. HONECE HOKTE, within striking distance and five or six wide throughout, couldn't offer the needed response as second best. KASINO DEALER tracked the pace four wide for a half, angled six or seven wide for the drive, was just off the winner for the final furlong and came up empty. THE RAIN IS GONE, close up between foes early, continued in a striking position to the stretch and failed to respond. SWAN, well placed in behind horses to the stretch, eased out three or four wide and flattened out when the test came. SWEET BERNICE improved position but never threatened. SMART CALLER tired on the turn. MALAWI BAY gained a slight edge inside early, battled with PASSIONS ROAR to the stretch and tired. PASSIONS ROAR angled in early, forced the pace three or four wide to the stretch and tired. JUST A KITTY never was prominent. J T'S LEMOON was outrun.
