PULASKI RUNNER, within striking distance and between foes four or five wide, closed determinedly to wear down SAUCY'S GOT IT in the late going. SAUCY'S GOT IT battled for the lead inside early, drew clear leaving the turn, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. FREE BRAVE, within easy striking distance and five wide much of the way, couldn't offer the needed late gain. WHYSOBLUE raced up close three or four wide into the final furlong and came up empty. CELTIC CHIEF, outrun early, passed tired foes six wide. BULL ALLIGATOR battled for the lead between foes until nearing the lane and couldn't keep pace. MR. WINCHESTER, forced out on the turn by ACTING ZIPPY when that one bore out, took up sharply and lost any chance. RED LAKE MINISTER, four or five wide, was bumped and forced to take up sharply when ACTING ZIPPY bore out and was finished. ACTING ZIPPY worked his way in behind horses, raced near the inside on the turn, bore out suddenly bothering MR. WINCHESTER AND RED LAKE MINISTER, knocked EASY TO REMEMBER sideways, was pulled up soon after and vanned off. EASY TO MEMBER, six wide on the turn, was slammed and knocked sideways nearing the five-sixteenths pole when ACTING ZIPPY bore out and unseated the rider. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
