BIRMAN tucked in to save ground through the first turn, shifted out and advanced between horses on the backstretch, continued the rally three wide through the second turn, split rivals entering the stretch, wore down REWARDABLE and was inching away late. THUNDER HIGHWAY pressed the pace two wide, settled off of the lead after a half, angled out and came again four wide, and fought on well to earn the place. REWARDABLE set the pressured pace along the inside, disputed the issue to the final furlong and grudgingly gave way. JACK IN THE PULPIT stalked the pace three deep, moved up to engage the leader on the second turn, but weakened between rivals in the drive and faded. KAKHAO raced wide throughout, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. NAVAJO PARK showed little. OUTLAW ACADEMY saved ground to no avail.
