RECUSE, outrun inside early, inched closer on the turn, came out six wide for the drive and drove clear late under strong handling. TAPPER TIME vied for the lead from early on while between foes four wide, took over, moved well clear but was not a match for the winner in the drive. CUBBIES GIRL, within easy striking distance and near the inside, couldn't muster the needed response. MIDNIGHT hopped at the start, raced off the inside and failed to rally. A CHANCE TO PASS broke a bit awkwardly, gained a position up close inside, dueled with the winner, was checked hard leaving the half-mile ground and fell back. MIA KITTY KITTY never reached serious contention. CAMP CONLEY attended the pace four wide for a half and tired. TIMELESS ORDER dueled for the lead from between foes early, continued forwardly for a half and tired. FOR SALE BY OWNER, outrun from the start, was pulled up in the upper stretch and vanned off.
