GRAND TRAVERSE settled along the inside, ranged into striking distance through the bend, waited in traffic leaving the turn, split horses entering the lane and quickly drew away to score with something left. STAR'S CLASSIC CAT attended the pace two wide, angled out to make his bid racing five wide, finished willingly but was no match for the winner through the lane. BOURNES LAND was unhurried early dropping well back, made a late rally circling five wide and was along for the show. ALABAMA VOW prompted the pace four wide, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. DA DA DA DUM rushed up to vie for the lead three wide, but faltered after a half and dropped out. SALTGRASS TRAIL disputed the pace on the inside for a half and stopped.
