CLEARSOUL, unhurried early, edged inside on the far turn, continued from the rail into the lane and outgamed STEPS in a stiff drive. STEPS, reserved early, made a sweeping run six wide nearing the final quarter, reached the front at the eighth pole but was outfinished. CHECK YA LATER, never far back, moved four wide approaching the stretch, leaned in exchanging bumps with LADY OF VALOR at the three-sixteenths pole, then couldn't offer the needed response. MARISTEN gained the lead early, raced four wide, held on well until the stretch and weakened. LADY OF VALOR, up close from the start while inside, angled out entering the stretch, exchanged bumps with CHECK YA LATER at the three-sixteenths pole, then flattened out. DEMON FEVER bobbed at the start and bumped the side of the gate, then tired after five furlongs. I AM ALPHABET SOUP failed to menace. MY MADELINE faded on the far turn. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF CHECK YA LATER AGAINST STEPS FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE UPPER STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
