Footnotes

YES BETH, reserved early while in behind horses, eased out seven or eight wide to commence her rally on the far turn, continued eight wide into the stretch and drove clear late. PATTY SEATTLE settled in behind rivals early, came out six or seven wide approaching the stretch, was bumped by KAY'S DAUGHTER and steadied when forced out for a stride, angled wider soon after and was going well late to earn the place. DYNA'S DYNAMO, outrun for seven furlongs, came out 10 wide entering the stretch and finished willingly. FEELING SO PRETTY, unhurried early, made a solid run from between foes four wide into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. STRUTTIN' attended the pace inside at once, gained a clear advantage in the upper stretch but faltered a sixteenth out. KAY'S DAUGHTER maneuvered near the inside on the backstretch, continued inside around the far turn, swung out entering the upper stretch, bumped PATTY SEATTLE, then flattened out. GHAZI DUST, forwardly place into the stretch while three or four wide, weakened when the test came. NITA WINS TOO had no rally in an even effort. BLUE'S FIRST BABY contested the pace early while between foes until nearing the stretch and weakened. JUSTAKISS angled in early to contest the pace four wide, battled forwardly to the stretch and weakened. JULIE TRULY was outrun.
