HEDGE YOUR RISK pulled to contention four wide, took over entering the stretch and widened through the drive. SEA OF CHANGE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and loomed a danger, but was unable to match strides with the winner. KICKBUTTAKENAMES opened clear to set the pace, was unable to match strides with the winner, weakened further in the drive but stayed on to hold the show. SULLY'S LANDING was close up five wide to the stretch and faded. PALLASO contended off of the inside to the stretch and tired. KRISMO was shuffled back at the start between horses, tucked in to save ground, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. WILD ROVER passed only the tiring ones. SUNDAY MISSILE was fractious in the gate, settled five wide and was never a factor. GOLDDIGGING was through early.
