Footnotes

KENTUCKY LIGHTNIN settled saving ground, shifted out and advanced between horses through the turn, was blocked and steadied near the quarter pole, came again entering the stretch and was up with a surge to prevail narrowly. BIG RING contended between horses, got through off of the inside entering the stretch, forged command inside the furlong marker, continued on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. DR. BILL was unhurried into stride along the inside, slipped through entering the stretch, was in tight nearing the eighth pole, shied and brushed the rail, fought on but weakened in the final yards and settled for the show. SON TSAR broke slow, made a middle move six wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive.

ROLL N SHINE was allowed to settle five wide, steadied off heels midway through the turn, came six wide to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. SARATOGA RED was forwardly placed along the inside, came up empty leaving the turn, drifted out through the drive and faded. Following the race SARATOGA RED was unsaddled on the backstretch and was vanned off. WATCH FIRE set the pressured pace four wide, opened clear on the turn, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. BOOSTER ROCKET contended between horses, was pinched back and steadied near the half mile marker, and showed little thereafter. LITTLE BOY LOST contested the pace between horses, but stopped before going a half. The jockey of DR. BILL lodged an objection against BIG RING for alleged interference in the final furlong, but following the Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
