Footnotes

WILLOW WIND, rated inside early, eased out four wide on the far turn to rally, reached the front in the upper stretch, then was hard ridden to hold sway. RUTLEDGE DANCER, in hand early while in behind foes three or four wide, made a bold run from between foes into the final furlong and slowly was gaining. MORE RIBBONS, outrun for a half, made a bold five wide run into the stretch, loomed prominently but couldn't muster the needed response. MY CHANEL went up early to vie for the lead outside of ANN'S SILVERLINING, gained a narrow advantage, held on well until the final furlong and weakened. CRAZYBOUTAMERCURY, outrun to the lane, improved position but wasn't a threat. HIGHER CIRCLE, five or six wide throughout, was empty in the drive. GENUINE APPEAL, also five or six wide throughout, never reached contention. SULKY SENORITA ducked out at the start, swerved in soon after, settled inside and tired. TACTICAL TRACEY edged in early to track the pace four wide, then faded entering the far turn. ANN'S SILVERLINING gained a narrow lead inside early, dueled with MY CHANEL, raced close up for five furlongs and tired.
