RED QUEEN, close up between foes early, inched to the fore nearing the final quarter, was engaged from the outside by RESOLUTION and gamely held that one safe under strong handling. RESOLUTION, unhurried in behind horses early, eased out four or five wide to rally approaching the stretch, battled on about even terms with the winner while outside that one through the drive and was outfinished. PAUSE FOR APPLAUSE, reserved near the inside early, inched closer on the far turn, eased out five wide about the five-sixteenths pole, had aim the late eighth but failed to respond. DEVILED SHRIMP, within easy striking distance while racing in behind the leaders to the stretch, maneuvered out four or five wide for the last eighth and failed to fire. PARA VIDINHA forced the pace three abreast to the stretch and tired. SANDTINA never was prominent. BEAM QUEEN gained a slight edge near the inside early, continued up close to the stretch and gave way. SEATTLE DANCING, well placed early, broke down just prior to going a half.
