GO FOR BROOK chased front-running EXCINTING JUSTICE early, took over from that one leaving the turn, then was kept to her task to win going away. GOLDEN DAWN stalked the pace four wide, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but couldn't threaten. SMOKIN' SPIRIT drifted out at the start, raced five or six wide and managed a mild gain. MIS MAX, outsprinted early, improved position while five wide. QUAKING ASP broke slowly in the air, was outrun to the lane never reached serious contention. DIVINE KRYSTAL was outrun and seven or eight wide in the final furlong. EXCITING JUSTICE moved clear two wide early, made the pace to the final quarter and gave way readily. MAJOR ALLIE, well placed four wide for three furlongs, weakened in the drive. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE TRAINER OF DIVINE KRYSTAL FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
