Footnotes

GRAND PIANO MAN unhurried while outrun, made a good inside middle move, angled out for the drive and finished well to be clear. MAJOR WINTERS set the pace inside, repulsed a bid by PRESENTS FOR BERTI on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch but was no match for the winner late. LOST APTITUDE reserved three wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and made a good late gain. PRESENTS FOR BERTI within striking distance three wide, made a run at the leader on the second turn but tired in the drive. MR. WATT closest to the early pace off the inside, tired in the stretch. COLONEL POTTER outrun early, raced in the four path on the second bend and was no threat. J B'S UNC forwardly placed along the inside, faded. WHERE'S WINSTON within reach while off the inside, stopped.
