DONE GONE prompted the pace three wide, took over with five-sixteenths to run, kicked clear and held a diminishing advantage. RIDE THE LIGHTNING attended the pace along the inside, got through and kept on well but was unable to bridge the gap. MEOWSER settled in hand, advanced between horses through the turn, angled out leaving the turn, bumped E. M. MAXIMUS nearing the three-sixteenths pole, continued on well and was making up ground. E. M. MAXIMUS broke slow, was unhurried into stride, commenced his rally five wide, was bumped and carried out further leaving the turn, stayed on fairly well but failed to improve position through the final furlong. GEOTHERMAL stalked the pace, moved up four wide to make a mild bid, was caught in tight between horses inside the quarter pole, angled in to find room but lacked the needed late response. FRANKIE AND JOE was away alertly to set the pressured pace toward the inside, was headed on the turn, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. LUMBERJACK was slow into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. ROMAN RAIDER was away slow, rushed up between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. ARGUMENTAL showed little. HEATED contended three wide for a half and stopped.
