Footnotes

TRAIL TRICK set the pace along the inside, turned back the bid of JILL GOLDEN entering the stretch, opened clear and widened. SIX STRONG LADY was allowed to settle, moved up three wide, split horses and was making up ground. STOLEN RUBIES attended the pace between horses, angled in leaving the second turn, found a seam between horses but lacked the needed late response. JILL GOLDEN pressed the pace three wide to the stretch and weakened. STRAWBERRY DELITE contended along the inside, got through entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. STE. MERE EGLISE made a middle move five wide, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. GATTINO was allowed to settle, finished with a mild rally between horses but failed to threaten. MOUNTABLE was hustled along four wide to the stretch and faded. GROVANNA broke slow and was never a factor. OUR BELLA GIRL was hustled along five wide, but stopped before going six furlongs. LAST COMMAND was outrun.
