Footnotes

SOLID PLATINUM, well placed from the outset while tracking the pace four or five wide, closed determinedly under pressure to be along in time. HARMONIC MISS, up close between foes early, gained the advantage on the turn, kicked well clear, then failed to last while dead heating with KALJOMI for second. KALJOMI, away in front, raced six wide and was slowly gaining at the end to finish on even terms with HARMONIC MISS for second. IMAFLASHYCAT, never far back and five or six wide, lacked a late response. RATHER HAVE RUBIES, bumped after the start by SATIABLE, was outrun to the stretch, made mild bid to reach contention nearing the final furlong and failed to continue. HARD BARGAIN hopped at the start to trail, was outrun to the stretch and improved position while never a threat. BID MADE, outrun into the lane, passed tired foes. ECHO HARBOR, forwardly placed inside into the

upper stretch, flattened out when the test came. DORAN'S MIRACLE, five or six wide, weakened leaving the turn. BARBIE'S DREAM tired approaching the stretch. SATIABLE came out at the start bumping RATHER HAVE RUBIES and was outrun. FUTURE SAINT gained the lead early, made the pace for nearly three furlongs and gave way.
