SARGE HUDSON vied for the lead off of the inside, opened clear midway through the turn, and widened through the drive. GOSPEL HOUR broke slow, rushed to contention toward the inside, steadied from tight quarters near the seven-sixteenths pole, was bottled up through the turn, checked hard with a quarter mile to run, angled out between rivals entering the stretch and kept on well to earn the place once clear. LATE STARTER stalked the pace three wide, was forced out further entering the turn, made a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. D' WILDCAT ROAD disputed the pace three wide, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and gave way. BAIL BONDSMAN was hustled along four wide in mid pack and went evenly. DOWNTOWN DRIGGS passed the tiring ones. DON'S BIRTHDAY broke a step slow and failed to respond. CONSOLER brushed the gate, was slow into stride and was never a factor. LIGHT OF THE STORM was bumped early and showed little thereafter.
