SEA FIGHTER settled saving ground, took closer order through the second turn, angled out five wide, reeled in the leaders nearing the furlong marker and steadily drew clear. ALL BORN SINNERS stalked the pace in hand off of the inside, ranged up three wide through the second turn, loomed large entering the stretch but was unable to match strides with the winner. TUFFER was unhurried into stride, advanced between horses, angled out five wide entering the stretch and finished willingly to earn the show. WOUND UP broke slow, rushed to the lead five wide, disputed the pace through the second turn and tired. HE'S SO WILD was rank to place between horses through the first turn, leveled into stride three wide, moved up five wide to make a mild bid on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. LIDOS ABIT SASSY dueled for the lead along the inside for six furlongs and dropped out. RAILROAD ROY chased three wide for five furlongs and stopped.
