TRANS CONTINENTAL was hustled along on the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BELLAMY'S ROSE was unhurried into stride, split horses leaving the turn, angled out five wide and improved position. LITTLE NIBLETS saved ground to little avail. NINJAS PRIZE was hustled along between horses, drifted out leaving the turn and faded. RIBBON TAFFY was forwardly placed off of the inside for a half and dropped out.
