SPEND A BUCK BABY, unhurried early, moved six wide on the stretch turn, continued in that manner and was hard ridden to prevail. BRUSHED BEAUTY, outrun and unhurried to the far turn while saving ground, circled rivals seven wide into the stretch, loomed boldly and hung. GLEN ARBOR, never far back, made a bold run from the rail to reach the front nearing the stretch, was clear for the last eighth but weakened late. IMAGE IN MOTION went up early to vie for the lead from between foes, loomed prominently for the drive but lacked a closing response. RICKS LITTLE MUSIC forced the pace to the far turn while three abreast and weakened gradually. GILDED WORDS failed to menace. SEA WITCH tired after a half. BOONE'S BAND dueled for the lead inside, took over but was finished a quarter-mile out.
