Footnotes

ABSOLUTE JACK came out bumping SMOKE N D C at the start, was never far back, raced five wide most of the way and wore down WES SIDE STORY under strong handling. WES SIDE STORY, well placed, raced between foes, edged nearer the inside when gaining the lead just before going a mile, made the pace into deep stretch and wasn't quite good enough. LOVE AND HONOR settled in behind horses, edged closer on the final turn, came out five or six wide for the drive and was gaining late. BENNIE BEN BENNY, well placed inside for 10 furlongs, angled out entering the lane but flattened out the last eighth. ADMIT improved position but wasn't a serious threat. PLEASANT WIND passed tired foes. ADREAMISBORN, rated along near the inside, was asked for more three furlongs out, angled out a bit entering the stretch and flattened out badly. SIR CEASAR gained a narrow lead early while four or five wide, managed a slight edge for nearly a mile and tired. MUST BE ST. NICK, briefly in front early, gave way badly upon going six furlongs. SMOKE N D C, bumped at the start, lost contact with the field before going a mile and was distanced.
