TORI'S TRIUMP gained the lead inside, repelled a bid from STORMCLOUDRISING concluding the turn, then held that one safe under strong handling. STORMCLOUDRISING chased the winner four wide throughout and wasn't good enough. QUICK ADVICE, outsprinted early, raced in behind horses, angled out four wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. MAMIE MOM, well placed in behind the leaders, was empty when the test came. CASEY BELLE stalked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and flattened out. ARCHIVIST failed to rally in an even effort. BLUE'S FIRST BABY never was prominent. HOURMISSREMY tired midway on the turn. TODDS TOOTSIE was outrun.
