Footnotes

YOU ARE MY VICE, never far back while following the leaders five wide, continued five wide into the final furlong and wore down front-running DEPENDABILITY under strong handling. DEPENDABILITY attended the pace four wide, took over on the turn, opened a clear lead in the upper stretch, then failed to last. BABBLING GIRL, outrun early, advanced six wide into the stretch but could gain only slightly in the late going. NO CASH, never far back, flattened out when the test came. DARBY'S CHARM dueled for the lead while near the inside between foes the opening half and weakened. BALLISTIC BABE failed to menace. MATTIE CAKES was used up inside dueling for the lead the opening three furlongs. SO BLUE gave way early and was distanced in the stretch. RISKY AGREEMENT, outrun from the start and wide on the backstretch, was pulled up before going a half and vanned off.
