Footnotes

NEVAEH'S SONG vied for the lead along the inside, shook off JAMIE'S TUNE inside the furlong marker, and drew clear through the final yards. GENIUS GOVENOR was allowed to settle into stride, angled in on the turn, got through to make her bid, and finished willingly to earn the place. JAMIE'S TUNE rushed up to dispute the pace three wide, weakened nearing the eighth pole and drifted out a bit as she faded. MAX OUT chased the dueling leaders two wide, but flattened out entering the stretch and gave way. CONVINCING was unhurried into stride, came three wide to make a belated gain from between horses, but failed to threaten. LITTLEMISSBLONDIE was slow into stride while along the inside, and passed only her tiring rivals. LEEDONNA was hustled along three wide to be close up, but came up empty leaving the turn and retreated. TRAIL OF SILVER broke slowly, was hustled along four wide to recover the lost ground, but faltered before going half and dropped out. PRINCESS GIOVANNI raced three wide and was through early.
