CONSTABULARY settled in hand, advanced five wide, drew even with a quarter to run, forged command and gradually edged clear. FORCHTENBERG stalked the pace three deep, launched his bid from between horses, was unable to match strides with the winner then was all out to hold the place. ITSALLBOUPTHCHASE was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the show. KINSALE WITH ME vied for the lead along the inside, but weakened during the drive and gave way. CITIZEN JOHN disputed the pace two wide, but faltered from between horses leaving the second turn and faded. RUNAWAY BANJO was forwardly placed along the inside for five furlongs and dropped out. NOROAMIN was unhurried into stride, made a middle move to close the gap, but drifted out through the second turn and stopped.
