PUNCHER'S CHANCE forced the pace along the inside, was no match for the winner but held on to be second best. VIBRANT REACTION ridden early go gain position, lacked a closing bid. STING JAMES reserved off the inside, had nothing left in the drive. BLADING SILVER outrun five wide, improved his position while no threat. KEENUS FROM LOUISA was no factor. EIGHTH ROCK four wide on the turn, never menaced. PROSPECT BREWING behind the leaders off the rail, faded. MAGIC INTERLUDE was no factor.
