ELOPED AGAIN gained the lead at the start, edged inside, drew off in the upper stretch and was kept to his task. MR. BUSTER, within easy striking distance, wasn't a threat in the drive while superior to the others. TIMBER WOLF, outprinted early, improved position while not a threat. MID DAKOTA swerved out at the start while breaking alertly, fell back outside approaching the stretch, then improved position while not a threat. CAJUN CLIFF pressed the winner into the stretch and tired. RITA'S ARCHANGEL failed to menace. CATNIRO was through upon going a half as was PORTAL. EAGLE PEAK gave way leaving the turn. MALICOTE was outrun.
