FIRE SLAM settled inside early, moved four wide while advancing on the turn, joined UNBRIDLED AMERICA while outside that one nearing the final furlong and measured him under confident hand urging. UNBRIDLED AMERICA settled near the inside early, made a bold run from the rail to reach the front at the eighth pole, then was outgamed. CAT GENIUS broke in the air, rushed to the lead three or four wide, drew clear on the turn, then weakened gradually when straightened for the drive. BIG TALKIN MAN was finished after a half.
