PLUTONIUM sprinted clear, set the pace out in the course, responded willingly when headed on the second turn and despite being bumped by the runner up several times in the final sixteenth, proved narrowly best. B'WANAGOLDMINE close up along the inside, waited briefly behind the leaders approaching the stretch, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly but missed. FIST OF RAGE within striking distance, moved to challenge four wide on the second turn, battled into the final furlong, drifted in to bump the winner several times then missed. LAKE PLEASANT outrun for a half, made a mild late bid. KING SNAKE closest to the pace, challenged near the rail on the second turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. INCLUDE THE BLING unhurried off the inside, was no threat. PATTI'S KITTEN was outrun.
