SHOFAR vied for the lead along the inside and drew off under steady urging. BANKIT close up while off the inside, lodged a mild bid for the place. WISE GUY KELLY outrun early, saved ground on the turn and rallied too late. STAR CHAMBER reserved early, raced in the three path on the turn and was no real threat. WHY STILLY WHY broke in the air, rushed five wide into the turn but tired in the drive. A NICKEL OUTLAW alternated for the lead off the inside and gave way. BISCUITS N BEER outrun to the stretch, was no threat. HOMER T could not menace three wide. ACE HIGH BLUFF stumbled at the start, recovered and raced within striking distance four wide but faded. GOT HOLY SPIRIT was no threat. SKIP THE DRAMA within striking distance along the inside, faded. MIRACULOUS MAX prompted the pace three wide and stopped. Finish margins furnished by Equibase track crew.
