WORTH AVE, outrun early, commenced a sweeping run five wide nearing the stretch, circled foes and drew off to win easily as the rider pleased. DOUBLE STRAW improved position to gain the place while not a threat to the winner. FEELING SO PRETTY, outrun to stretch, improved position while not a threat. IMELDA'S SHOES raced evenly while not a threat. QUEEN'S LEGEND tired at the far turn. ZANJA forced the pace from early on, gained a narrow lead between calls but gave way into the stretch. INLAY forced the pace to the stretch and gave way. FRIPPET dueled for six furlongs and gave way. MAKEINPARADICE was outrun. FARM A BERRY stopped badly.
